- Accessible Garden Update from Anthony
 - o Krista sent out photos via email to the council, build is done!
 - Home Depot build is scheduled for the spring
 - o The Trillium deadline was met and a report is being produced
- New website update from Anthony
 - There was a meeting with some gardeners and interested council members
 - o The group looked at garden websites from various gardens like Toronto and Hamilton
 - o Good points and what to avoid were collected in an informal specification
 - Stephanie sent out requests for quotes and is gathering input on choosing a vendor
 - o Funding for the website has been generously provided by Public Health
